Color the birds that **cannot** fly **RED**.*



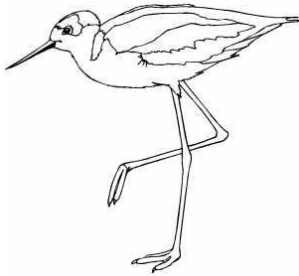




Some birds have two toes facing forward and two facing backward to help them climb trees.

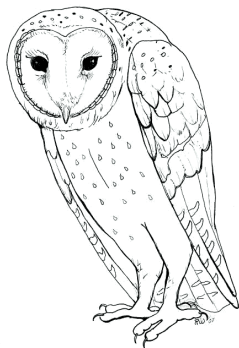


Some birds have webbed feet for swimming.

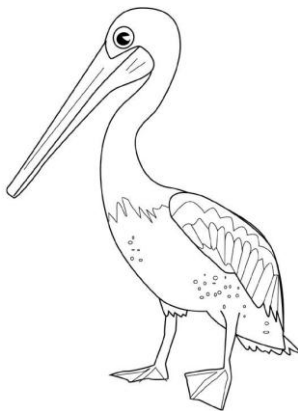


Some birds called raptors (birds of prey) have sharp talons for grasping their prey.

and a shape of **your choice**  around the climbing birds!



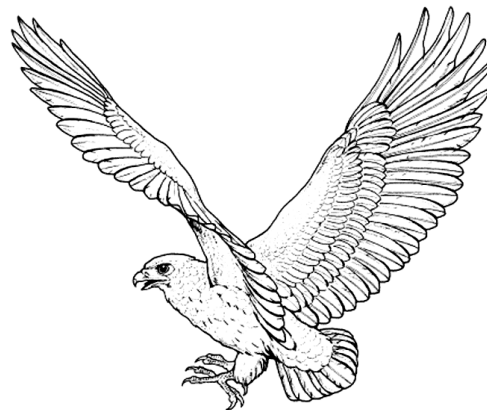

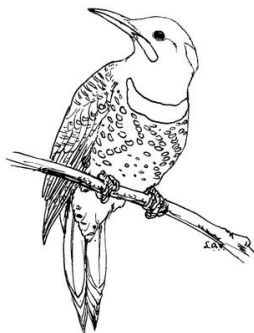
