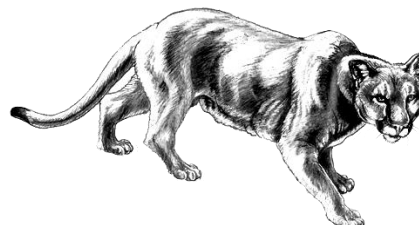

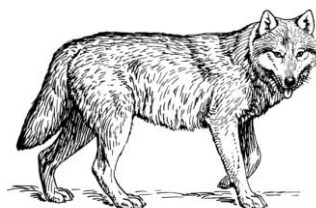

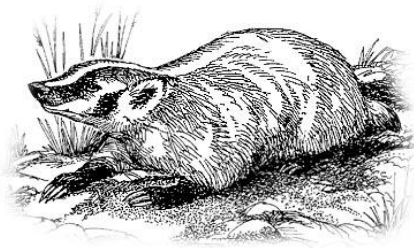
Black-Tailed Deer

Marvelous Mammals
