Some birds have special adaptations to survive in wetlands habitats:

Birds that feed in **deep water** have **webbed feet** for swimming.



Birds that feed along the shore or in **shallow water** do not have webbed feet.



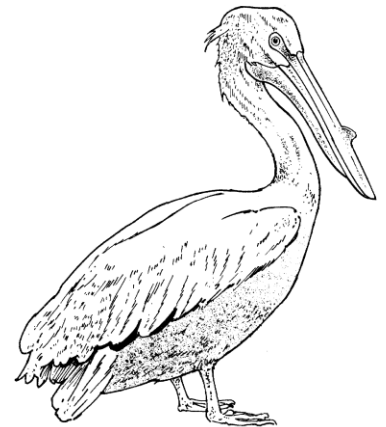
*Color the birds that feed in **deep water** BLUE and the birds that feed in **shallow water** RED.*

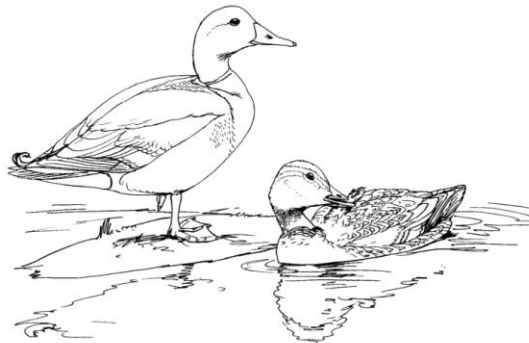

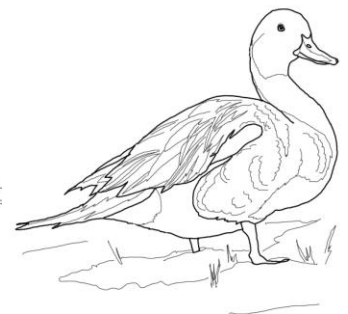
American White Pelican

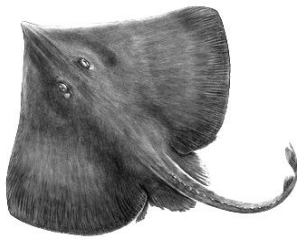
Wild Wetlands
